Noble Network Students Earn the Most Chicago Posse Scholarships

Noble Network students earned 12 of the 86 Chicago scholarships awarded by the Posse Foundation this year. Posse scholarship winners are selected through a very rigorous process including written applications and several interviews. The Posse Scholarship award is four years of full college tuition. More students from Noble campuses won Posse Scholarships this year than from private and selective enrollment schools.

Rauner College Prep boasts 6 Posse Scholars, the most of any school in Chicago.

Noble Street College Prep has four winners and Pritzker College Prep followed with two. Noble Network Posse scholars are attending schools including Oberlin College, Pomona College and Denison University. The Noble Network has an overall college matriculation rate of 89%.
