

Posse golfers round up aid for student leaders

The Posse Foundation held its sixth annual golf outing and reception at the Skokie Country Club in Glencoe on Sept. 13. The event, attended by 160, raised a record-setting \$150,000. Golf, a jazz cocktail reception and live auction were on the program.

All proceeds supported Posse Chicago, a college access and youth leadership development program founded in 2000 that identifies, recruits and trains incredible urban public high school students and sends them in posses -- supportive, multicultural teams of 10 students -- to top colleges and universities across the U.S.

Posse's college partners award Posse Scholars four-year, full-tuition leadership scholarships. As a result of the program, 90 percent of Posse Scholars graduate from college.
