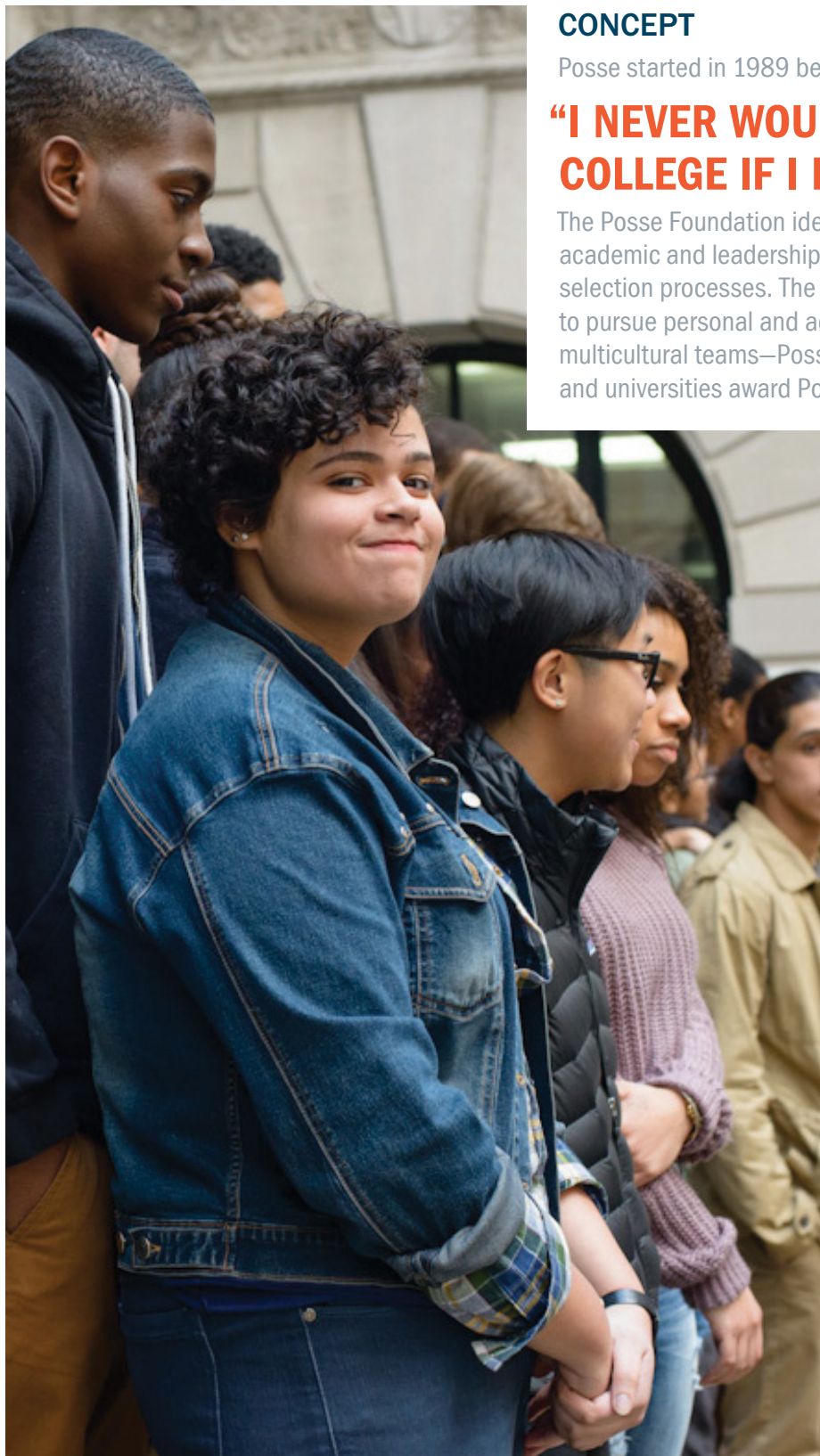

Posse started in 1989 because of one student who said,
